Create a non-chronological report about them using subheadings like: Appearance, Habitat, Food, Movement, Offspring.</p>
<p>Computing Collect some data to answer a question (e.g. What is your favourite animal? Which letters are in your name?) Create a pictogram of your results.</p> 	<p>Maths Work on your maths facts recall (addition and subtraction facts to 10 and 20; 2x, 5x, 10x, 3x tables). Learn as many as you can off by heart with quick recall- we will need this to support our future maths learning. (TTRockstars, Hit the Button, etc)</p>	<p>Art Create a sculpture of a person or another animal. You could use clay, playdoh, papier mâché etc.</p> 
<p>PE Practise your ball skills by playing throwing and catching games, e.g. How many claps can you do between your throws? Can you catch with one hand?</p> 	<p>Science Design your own animal that would be part of an animal group (reptile, mammal, bird, fish, amphibian). Choose the parts your animal has carefully to make sure it fits its animal group but be creative! Create a fact file about it and draw pictures of it when it is young and when it is an adult.</p>	<p>Geography Go on a visit to a place of interest. Take photos or create a map of human (city, village, shop, factory, road, bridge) and/or physical features (mountains, hills, valleys, river, sea, cliff, waterfall). If you can't visit anywhere, you could create a map of your own made-up place (with labels).</p>

Complete at least 3 challenges so that you make a vertical, horizontal or diagonal line. You must include the middle square. Colour in each square as you complete that activity. To be complete no later than **Monday 23rd February** when we will celebrate and share all your projects. The winning learning log will be awarded the 'Learning Log Trophy'.
