<p><b><u>Expressive Arts</u></b></p> <p>Use boxes, junk and collage materials to make a model of your favourite type of transport.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Bake with a grown up! You could use scales to weigh ingredients or use less formal methods such as capfuls to measure amounts.</p>	<p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>Practise writing letter graphemes and sound out to spell three letter words.</p> <p>You could make simple labels for objects around your home. For example: cup, pot, box, pen</p>
<p><b><u>Physical Development</u></b></p> <p>Practise throwing, catching and kicking a ball.</p> 	<p><b><u>Literacy</u></b></p> <p>Read your Little Wandle phonics book <b>five times a week</b> and practise Tricky Words.</p>	<p><b><u>Music</u></b></p> <p>Listen to music from around the world. What is your favourite type of music? Can you create a dance to go with the music?</p>
<p><b><u>PSHE-Road Safety</u></b></p> <p>Talk to adults about why it is important to hold hands and follow safety rules when you are near roads.</p> <p>Remember STOP, LOOK, LISTEN and THINK. Practise at home with a grown up.</p>	<p><b><u>Understanding the World</u></b></p> <p>Have a walk with an adult around your home village.</p> <p>Take a photo of your favourite places so you can talk about them in school.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths</u></b></p> <p>Arrange your soft toys, cars etc. in order of size. You may decide to order them by height or length. Explain to an adult using words such as longer, shorter, tallest, shorter than....</p>

**Complete at least 3 challenges** so that you make a vertical, horizontal or diagonal line. You must include the middle square. Colour in each square as you complete that activity. To be complete no later than Monday 23rd February when we will celebrate and share all your projects. The winning learning log will be awarded the 'Learning Log Trophy'.
