<p><b>English</b></p> <p>Write a postcard to a family member to update them about your latest news. Remember your capital letters, finger spaces and punctuation. Try and impress them with your neat writing.</p>	<p><b>Reading</b></p> <p>See if you can spot the Phase 5 digraphs 'ea', 'oy' and 'ay' and any split vowel digraphs while you are out and about – take photos or write down what you find.</p>	<p><b>PSHE</b></p> <p>See if there are any household chores that you could help your grown-up with (perhaps keeping your bedroom tidy?). Write/draw/photograph to show how you have learned about responsibility at home.</p>
<p><b>PE</b></p> <p>Create a fitness challenge of your choosing and complete it over a few days. Write down or draw/photograph your challenge.</p>	<p><b>Phonics</b></p> <p>Read three of the weekly phonics home learning sheets. (A grown-up to sign and include in the home learning log)</p>	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Research two countries and see what their climate is like. Are they hotter or colder than our climate? Use Google maps to explore areas of interest.</p>
<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>See which everyday material (glass, plastic, metal and wood) is the most common in your house. Write down your findings by using a tally chart.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Practice putting groups of objects into half and counting carefully to help you understand what half of an amount is (e.g. half of 10 is 5)</p>	<p><b>DT</b></p> <p>Create a frame structure (such as a small chair/table) using recycling items and decorate it.</p>

Complete at least 3 challenges so that you make a vertical, horizontal or diagonal line. You must include the middle square. Colour in each square as you complete that activity.
