<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Understanding the World</u></p> <p>Look at and sequence photos of your growth from a baby or those of your family.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Play games by rolling dice and moving a counter along a track or play outdoor skittles/target games to help with counting on and calculation skills.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p>Practise spelling words using the games on Spelling Shed.</p> 
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Expressive Arts and Physical Development</u></p> <p>Create a collaged picture (using different materials and scissor skills) of a garden, a favourite plant or flower. You may also want to draw and use paint to add to your image.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Literacy</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Read your Little Wandle phonics book five times a week</p> <p>and practise reading and writing Tricky Words listed on bookmarks.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical Development</u></p> <p>Practise holding balances for a count of 10 on different body parts (e.g. one foot) and making different body shapes. Link these together with different ways to move around.</p>
<p><u>PSHE-</u> Explore changes in the weather/seasons</p> <p><u>Maths-</u> Measuring time</p> <p>Keep a diary or weather chart using symbols or words. Talk about experiences you have had in different types of weather. What did you do? What did you wear?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Understanding the World</u></p> <p>With an adult, help to clear the garden and plant spring plants or seeds. Watch and measure your plants as they grow.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Go for a solid 3D shape hunt around your home. How many different objects can you find that are spheres, cubes, cuboids, cones, cylinders, pyramids. Take photos.</p> 

Complete at least 3 challenges so that you make a vertical, horizontal or diagonal line. You must include the middle square. Colour in each square as you complete that activity.
