


## Tic Tac Toe Half-Termly Learning Log

### Reception Summer Term 1: Amazing Animals

<p><b><u>Understanding the World</u></b></p> <p>Look for and take care of the wildlife living in your garden. What animals did you find?</p> 	<p><b><u>Maths: Sharing and Grouping</u></b></p> <p>Make your own number cards to ten (numerals and amounts). Then share out the cards and play a game of 'snap'. Share out dominoes and play number games. Share out snacks and treats...Make it fair! How many do you each have?</p>	<p><b><u>Literacy: Writing</u></b></p> <p>Practise writing your letters (graphemes) with the correct formation. Draw pictures of a favourite animal. Write labels on the picture or write a sentence about your animal. (For example:- tail, fin, ear)</p>
<p><b><u>Expressive Arts and Physical Development</u></b></p> <p>Make a model or paint a picture of a favourite animal.</p> 	<p><b><u>Literacy: Reading</u></b></p> <p><b>Read your Little Wandle phonics book five times a week</b> and practise new Tricky Words on bookmarks.</p>	<p><b><u>Physical Development</u></b></p> <p>Make a plan and set up an obstacle course in your garden. Think about adding activities to practise different skills, such as balances or throwing.</p>
<p><b><u>PSHE- Differences and Diversity</u></b></p> <p>With an adult, talk about similarities and differences between people and groups of people. Write and complete: <b>Being kind means....</b></p>	<p><b><u>Understanding the World</u></b></p> <p>With an adult, help to look after a pet. Photograph and write about how you have helped and what you needed to do to keep your pet happy and healthy.</p>	<p><b><u>Maths, Literacy and Expressive Arts</u></b></p> <p>Set up a role play shop. You could make a pet shop with your soft toys or maybe a garden centre. Add prices, make posters and signs, and use real coins to pay.</p>

Complete at least 3 challenges so that you make a vertical, horizontal or diagonal line. You must include the middle square. Colour in each square as you complete that activity.

To be complete no later than **Monday 1st June 2026** when we will celebrate and share all your projects. The winning learning log will be awarded the 'Learning Log Trophy'.
