This could be an illustration of a sports match; a painting of a selection of different animals; or a clay model of a sports person.</p>	<p><i>Leavers' Production</i></p> <p>Learn the songs and script for the leavers' production – this will come in due course.</p>	<p><i>Design Technology</i></p> <p>Design and make an item which could be associated with your hobby. This could be a model dart board; a model fish tank; a model football pitch. Be creative!</p>
<p><i>Computing</i></p> <p>Using purple mash, create a game which incorporates the theme of your hobby. E.G. An animal themed game; a sports themed game.</p>	<p><i>English</i></p> <p>Research information about a topic of your choice. Then record this as either a mini-book, PowerPoint presentation and present this to the class.</p>	<p><i>History</i></p> <p>Research information about the history of your hobby. This could be about a famous person who also enjoyed the hobby; how the hobby came to be popular; or how the hobby has changed over time.</p>
