Communication and Language

Listen carefully and ask questions. Explain, reason and express feelings, thoughts and ideas. Use past, present and future tenses in clearly spoken sentences.

Listen and talk about stories including characters, settings and events. Make predictions.

Little Wandle Phonics and Reading

Phoneme Sounds Consolidation and use of long vowel sounds in words. Words ending in -s, -es, ing, -ed, er, est


Tricky Words Consolidation-All words covered in Reception. Read these with automaticity and spell some correctly when writing.

Reading Books: Your child will have a reading for pleasure book from the library for you to share with them. They will also have a Little Wandle Scheme Book to read to you at least 5x per week.

Nursery Rhymes-

Sing a Song of Sixpence, Bobby Shaftoe, Owl and the Pussy Cat, I saw a ship a sailing,

Religions and world views: Christians/ Muslim.



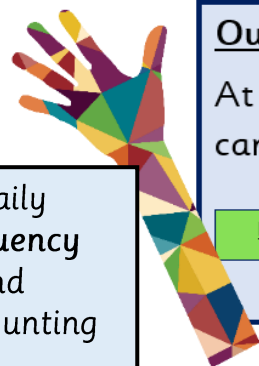
