Year Reception – Autumn 1 (Theme: It's Good To Be Me)

<u>Literacy</u> What is your favourite book or story? Draw a picture of the book or a character from your favourite book. Can you explain why you like it? What is your favourite part?	<u>Maths</u> Help at home to match and sort out socks. Look at the patterns on different socks and find different patterns around your home. Copy or photograph them for your Learning Log.	<u>Literacy</u> Practise your name. You can build your name with letter tiles, or write your name using pencils, pens, crayons, chalks outdoors, paint, sticks in mud/sand, or any other interesting way of creating your name.
<u>Physical Development</u> What is your favourite type of exercise? Have a photo taken or draw a picture.	<u>Literacy</u> Practise and learn phoneme sounds. Practise writing the graphemes (lower case letters).	<u>Music and Singing</u> What is your favourite nursery rhyme or counting song? Practise at home. You could have a photo taken, performing it to your family.
<u>PSHE-Managing Self</u> Practise putting on your coat (or another item of clothing that is tricky) and learn to fasten it up. This will help you get ready for colder weather in Autumn and Winter.	<u>Understanding the World</u> Look at pictures of you growing up. Talk about how you have changed. What can you do now that you couldn't do when you were a baby or a toddler.	<u>PSHE-Relationships</u> Draw and label a picture of your family.

Complete at least 3 challenges so that you make a vertical, horizontal or diagonal line. You must include the middle square. Colour in each square as you complete that activity. To be completed no later than Tuesday 3rd November when we will celebrate and share all your projects. The winning learning log will be awarded the 'Learning Log Trophy'.
