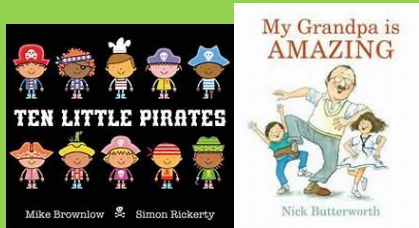

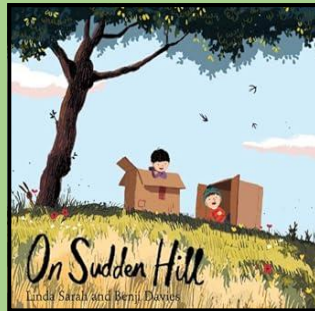

In Year 1, we focus on developing the key literacy skills needed for successful reading and writing:
